#### CAN PETIT CAVA, PENEDES

Bodegas Can Petit is a small, boutique cava bodega owned by Gonzalez Byass family, located near Sant Sadurni de Anoia. The bodega and its estate vineyards are actually in Espiells, which is the highest point in elevation in the Penedes region. The high altitude contributes to a slower maturation of the grapes, which produces wines with a higher acidity. The bodega owns 50 acres of estate vineyards and controls another 250 acres with long term contract. The vineyard enjoys a warm Mediterranean climate and The soil, which is alluvial in origin, is formed by a lime-arcillous layer which provides a balanced base for the vines to grow in. The wine is a blend of 55% Macabeo and 45% Parellada.

Winemaking is overseen by Damià Deas who has been in charge of Finca Can Petit since 1985. He has personally supervised the planting of the vineyards and the construction of the new bodega. Delicious fresh crisp creamy Cava – highly recommended.

Produced from vineyards around Hilmar California, Hilmar Springs pays homage to the Dosanjh Almond Ranch where the Hilmar Springs concept was born. For and entry level range this delivers superb fruit

quality in a classy looking package. The range is bottled in Burgundy bottles.

# WINE OF ARGENTINA

#### PARA DOS, MENDOZA

The Para Dos Malbec has punched well above the price point since its launch in the UK, in spite of the difficult harvest in 2016 where up to 50% of the fruit was lost due to frost and the subsequent price hikes, this is still a remarkably good Malbec for the money.

With vineyards at an average altitude of 3.937 feet, this is one of the largest cool climate vineyards in Mendoza which is important as this suits the Sauvignon Blanc grape and helps retain vitality, freshness and acidity whilst the Torrontes in the blend gives the wine the aromatics and fruit driven flavours, but in a subtle understated way, an excellent wine for matching with Indian and Thai cuisine.

#### NORTHERN RHONE

#### DOMAINE LES CHENETS 2013, CROZES HERMITAGE

From producer Domaine Les Chanets, this Crozes Hermitage is 100% Syrah from vines on average 15-30 years old grown on limestone and clay soil. This has the classic black fruits, a touch of black olive, some spice and nice grip, excellent with roast duck.

## SOUTHERN RHONE

#### RESERVES DES ARMOIRIES, COTES DU RHONE

The Reserve des Armoires wines are made by Jean-Francois Pasteurel as the Terres d'Auvignon, a group of wine growers in the Southern Rhone that epitomise the regions complex terroirs, the vines used for the Cotes du Rhone are over 40 years old. The wines are made in a traditional way with wild yeast ferments in cement tanks and bottled with very light fining and filtration.

#### DOMAINE DAMPT, CHABLIS

CHABLIS VIEILLES VIGNES. DOMAINE DAMÂPT

The 2016 vintage was one of the most difficult in the history of Chablis, severe frost in mail followed by hail meant that some producers lost nearly 50% of their harvest, the result has been a Chablis shortage and major price rises, happily Domaine Dampt has seen only moderate price increases and the wines remain excellent quality. Domaine Dampt uses concentrated grapes to produce a wonderful aromatic, stone fruit, mineral Chablis with ageing potential.

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Fouchaume is one of the finest 1er Cru's located on the right bank of the River Serin, adjacent to the Grand Cru vineyards, therefore, the wines have a greater degree of richness and complexity than many of the left bank 1er Crus. Made from old vines aged between 50-70 years. The old vines give a wonderful aromatic complexity with a good balance of both citrus and mineral flavours typical of good Chablis, this will age for 5-10 years.

Michel Pacquet makes several different wines, but we have selected the Les Terres Noires vineyard as it offers more depth concentration and richness than the standard cuvee.

#### DOMAINE PIERRE VESSIGAUD, POUILLY FUISSE POULLY FUISSE VIEILLES VIGNES

Pierre Vessigaud makes fantastic Pouilly Fuisse from his 13.5 acre organic vineyard, 100% Chardonnay which has been barrel fermented in older oak barrels that are from 2-10 years old. As this wine is a blend of different micro climates from Fuissé it has a a complex structure, using only hand picked grapes, wild yeast fermentation, this is a true artisan wine. The Estate has been working organically since 1998 and officially since 2010.

DOMAINE VAUDOISEY CRUSEFORD	
MEURSAULT VILLAGES	

A bright golden wine with 12 months raging in oak barrels. The vineyard is at between 280 and 450 metres above sea-level, the vineyards occupy the best-exposed sides of valleys which run east-west at right angles to the axis of the Côte. Rich, toasty, buttery Meursault with hints of hazelnut - a classic.

## **RED BURGUNDY**

#### FLEURIE, CHATEAU GAILLARD

The wines from Beaujolais have undergone something of a renaissance in recent years, helped by a string of good vintages, the wines offer a fruitiness and lightness tannins that make them unique, very food friendly wines. The terrain of the village of Fleurie is hillier with more schist and granite soil composition than what is found in the regions of the Beaujolais AOC, therefore, the wine has the potential to be of higher quality and to age well, the Ch Gaillard wines are traditionally made, so no bubblegum flavours from Carbonique maceration here - just good honest Fleurie.

Branded as the 'affordable Italian luxury', Versare are stylishly presented entry level house wines that offer a wide range of popular grape varieties under one label. Presented in a stylish screwcap design, Versare range has nine wines offering great value for money with the excellent Pinot Grigio as well as a dual varietal version Garganega Pinot Grigio. The Pinot Noir is worth a look if you want a lighter fruitier red.

Cortefresca winemaker Marco Dante produces a modern style of Italian single varietal wines, the Pinot Grigio has a depth and concentration of flavor that is rare at this price point, if anything the PG Rose is even better, very pale pink, fruity yet on the dry side, it is really quite sophisticated at this level. The Merlot is as you would expect, light bodied, juicy with smooth tannins and a refreshing rip of cherry fruit acidity.

Produced in Campo de Borja where Garnancha thrives, all the wine making is overseen by Master of Wine Fernando Mora. Campo de Borja wine making tradition dates back to the 12th century and winemaking in the region is heavily dependent on a high portion of old vines. Diverse "terrors" and generally low-yielding vines producing wines of structural and aromatic complexity. The area benefits from a continental climate with cool, dry "Cierzo" winds in the winter and Mediterranean influences in the summer. These extreme climates and contrasts between daytime and nighttime temperatures help to produce wines with good acidity, intense colour and pleasing tannins.
